## FEE BREAKDOWN PER SEMESTER:

Tuition & mandatory fees:	\$12,100 (including books and course access fees)
Meal Plan:	\$2800
Housing Fees:	\$1700

**Total First Semester Fees: \$16,650**

### *Possible additional Fees:*

- Students wanting a private room (if available)
- Freshmen in the C.S. Lewis Honors program that choose to live in College Drive (CDA) or Ware Street Apartments (WSA)
- Lab fees (depending on students' major or course selection)
- Students wishing to take more than 18 credit hours.

### *Scholarship Estimates per Semester:*

- TOPS (For Louisiana Students that qualify):  
\$2850-\$4250/Semester depending on level of TOPS *as determined by the State of Louisiana*
- LCU Scholarships:  
\$750-\$4250/Semester as determined by test scores, GPA, and housing choices.
- Pell Grants:  
\$370-\$3697 *as determined by the U.S. Department of Education.*
- Federal Government Student Loans:  
Up to \$2750 or \$4750 for an independent student.
- Private student loans are available and can go up to the total cost of Attendance. *More information about our lending partners is available on our website.*
- Federal Parent Plus loans are also available and can go up to \$10,000/semester.
- Many Churches & places of worship offer scholarships for students attending Louisiana Christian. *Check with your church to see if they offer these awards for their parishioners or Associations.*
- The Louisiana Baptist Convention has stipulated scholarships available for students attending Louisiana Christian. *Students can access and apply for those on their website.*
