Meet Your Navigators

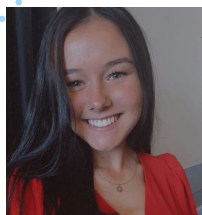
Anna Albury

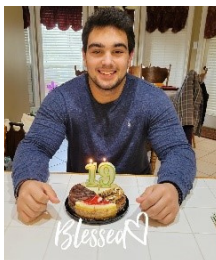


Toriance Fontenot

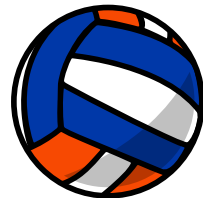
