

HOW TO ACCESS MAC ADDRESS FOR THE FOLLOWING:

PS4

- Navigate to the "Settings" icon (located on the far left).
- Select the "System" icon under the Settings menu.
- You will see your MAC address listed on this screen.

PS3

- Start the PlayStation 3
- Select the System Settings icon
- Select System Information
- The MAC Address will be located on this page.

Xbox One

- Press the "Menu" button on your controller.
- Navigate to the Settings page.
- Select Network.
- Select Advanced Settings.
- MAC address will be listed next to Wireless MAC on the right hand side of the screen.

Xbox 360

- From the Xbox Dashboard, go to My Xbox (select the Xbox logo on the controller) > Settings > System Settings
- Select Network Settings
- Select Wired Network or Wireless Network based on your connection to the internet
- Once you are in the correct network tab, Select Configure Network > Additional Settings > Advanced Settings
- The MAC address will be listed at the bottom of the screen.

Amazon FireStick

- From the Fire TV Stick's home screen, scroll over to "Settings".
- Select "My Fire TV".
- Select "About".
- Scroll down to "Network". Your MAC Address will be on this page.

Roku

- From the Home screen, press Up to make the Menu Bar appear.
- Select Settings.
- Select Player Info.

Apple TV

- Go to the main menu on your Apple TV, and select "Settings."
- In the Settings Menu, select "About."
- Here you can find your MAC Address listed as the "Wireless ID"

Nintendo Switch

- Select System Settings from the home screen
- Select Internet
- Your System MAC Address should be displayed on this screen.
- If the System MAC Address is not displayed on this screen, select Internet Settings.
- Scroll to the bottom and note the System Mac Address.
